Certified Patient Care Technician (CPCT)	6 Months	Prepares students for healthcare settings by covering medical procedures, EKG monitoring, phlebotomy, patient mobility, and bedside care, equipping them to effectively meet patient needs and improve well-being.
Certified Dental Assistant (CDA)	6 Months	Specialized training in dental care, preparing students to support dentists in both clinical and administrative roles.
Certificate in Caregiving	6 Months	Designed to empower students with the skills and knowledge needed to deliver compassionate and professional care to a wide range of individuals, including the elderly, children, and individuals with special needs.
Certificate in Phlebotomy	6 Months	Provides a comprehensive understanding of blood collection techniques, safety protocols, and patient interaction, preparing students to work confidently in healthcare settings.
Community Health Assistant	6 Months	Equips students to become proactive agents of change by addressing health concerns, promoting disease prevention, and advocating for improved healthcare access within
